Fare RulesFares are per person, round-trip and valid for travel in economy class from the USA January 1 – February 11, 2010, and to the USA January 5 – February 11, 2010. Tickets must be purchased by November 26, 2009. U.S. and foreign government imposed taxes and fees of up to \$105.00 per person are additional and due with final payment. A September 11th security fee of \$2.50 per person per U.S. enplanement is additional and due with final payment. Ticketing must be completed within 1 day after reservations are made. Seats are limited and may not be available on all flights. Change penalties of \$150.00 and other restrictions may apply. Economy class passengers are allowed two pieces of checked baggage, but a fee of \$25.00 will apply for the second checked bag. A ticketing fee of \$20.00 will be charged when purchasing tickets at Air Jamaica ticketing outlets. There is no ticketing fee charged for purchases made via AirJamaica.com. Tickets are non-refundable.
