

`Rise Again` Sings Caribbean artists Of Haiti

Jamaican-born reggae star, Shaggy, has pulled together a number of Caribbean artists to sing for Haiti.

Shaggy, Sean Paul, Sean Kingston, Etana, Tessanne Chin, Haitian musician Belo, David Rudder, Edwain Yearwood and soca singers Alison Hinds and Destra Garcia among others have come together to help the survivors of Haiti. The song, `Rise Again`, was written by Shaggy.

The team hopes to raise money for earthquake survivors in Haiti.
