Bob Marley's Last Live Recording For Sept. Release

The final live concert of reggae legend, Robert `Nesta` Marley, is set to hit stores next month.

Marley fans will be able to obtain the special double CD in eco-friendly packaging on a limited regional release through Tuff Gong Distribution on September 23, 2010.

The CD captures Marley's last concert at Pittsburgh's Stanley Theatre on September 23, 1980, where the late reggae legend urged all to Get Up, Stand Up, and they responded loudly with 'wo yo yo yo.' Later they discovered they had witnessed history as it was in fact Bob's last performance as Marley passed away on May 11, 1981.

Live Forever encapsulates the energy of that performance through the original live recording, captured on tape by Marley's engineer Dennis Thompson.

The album also includes live renditions of: `Uprising,` `Coming In From The Cold,` `Work,` `Zion Train,` `Redemption Song` and `Could You Be Loved.` The entire concert, from his opening song to the final applause, spans the special double album.
