

Fantasia to perform in Jamaica this month

Internationally acclaimed R&B/Soul singer, Fantasia Barrino will become the latest artiste to grace Jamaica's presence with a performance as she prepares to headline an event later this month.

The former American Idol winner will perform at an event, dubbed Wishes: The Love Song on April 21 at the Constant Spring Golf Club in Kingston. Fantasia leads the line of international acts on the show's bill as she will be joined by R&B singer, J Holiday, who's universally known for his 2007 chart-topping hit, Bed.

Additionally, the event, promoted by B.P.E Caribbean, features appearances from popular local, Dancehall/Reggae acts such as Chino, Denque and Ikaya.
