

US Embassy to give boats to Jamaican police

The United States (US) Embassy is expected to hand over 10 boats to the Jamaica Constabulary Force to aid Jamaica's crime fighting efforts at sea.

A handover ceremony is planned for this Wednesday to begin at 9:00 am at the Office of the Police Commissioner on Old Hope Road.
